The two-time Pulitzer Prizewinning author of *On Human Nature* and *The Meaning of Human Existence* offers here his own personal, luminous description of the wonders of Gorongosa, beautifully complemented by 60 of Piotr Naskrecki's photographs. The book also includes a bonus DVD of Academy Awardwinning director Jessica Yu's documentary, *The Guide*, which chronicles how Wilson inspired a young man to help in the reconstruction of the park. "As usual, [Edward O.] Wilson's observations carry more weight than the descriptions of a simple naturalist.
