

In On the Road, Jack London relates the tricks that hoboes used to evade train crews, and reminisces about his travels with Kelly s Army. Jack London later credited his story-telling skill to the hobo s necessity of concocting tales to coax meals from sympathetic strangers. As London confessed in this book, there was a woman in the state of Nevada to whom I once lied continuously, consistently, and shamelessly, for the matter of a couple of hours. I don t want to apologize to her. Far be it from me. But I do want to explain. Unfortunately, I do not know her name, much less her present address. If her eyes should chance upon these lines, I hope she will write to me. Though different than Call of the Wild or White Fang, Jack London continues to deliver in this book. London s On the Road is quite likely the inspiration for Jack Kerouac s more famous rendition, written more than 50 years later.
